**Description:** *Mercy Housing's [Reynoldstown Senior Residences](#) is an award-winning example of affordable housing for seniors in an area that has seen significant investment and growth in the last several decades. When gentrification and displacement began to pick up, longtime residents came together to advocate for affordable housing, hoping to be able to stay in their historically Black neighborhood that has been home to generations of families and community leaders. Against the backdrop of the Atlanta Beltline, a multi-use trail and light rail transit system on a former railway corridor, this development offers one example of use of the Beltline's Affordable Housing Trust Fund.*
