Description

Colorado Coalition for the Homeless (CCH) is one of the leading organizations responding to homelessness in the country. At the forefront of the Coalition's groundbreaking work is its health and housing efforts. It operates five federally qualified health centers (FQHC), including the Stout Street Health Center, the largest and most comprehensive program in downtown Denver, which serves over 13,000 patients annually. It operates 20 PSH and affordable properties that support more than 3,300 households, as well as a deep array of support services. We will visit the health center and CCH's new Recuperative Care Center, a supportive housing property, and discuss their approach to permanent supportive housing.
