<u>Community Land Trusts</u> – On Common Ground is a <u>new book that describes the growth of community land</u> <u>trusts</u> around the globe and includes a chapter from Brenda Torpy, CEO of Champlain Housing Trust in Vermont. As Brenda notes, given the moment we are living and with racial justice activism sweeping the US and other IHP countries, the CLT's model's roots in the civil rights movement of the 60's is a timely historical perspective on equitable and collective community development strategies.
