Mercy Magnuson Place: Adaptive Reuse and Community Partnership

Description: Mercy Magnuson Place, a historic naval housing redevelopment owned and operated by Mercy Housing Northwest and located in one of Seattle's largest parks, includes 148 studio, one-, two- and three-bedroom affordable apartments, an early learning center and neighborhood health clinic. This off-site will highlight a unique and complex adaptive reuse project, thoughtful community partnerships, and interconnected amenities in a major urban park that includes numerous other public and nonprofit uses.
