The Rise on Madison and Blake House: Creative Approaches to Permanent Supportive Housing

OFF-SITE SESSION

Description: Seattle's first affordable housing high-rise in over 50 years is a joint development by Bellwether Housing and Plymouth Housing featuring 250 apartments of workforce housing and 112 studio apartments for seniors who have experienced chronic homelessness. Conveniently located to public transport, it features a partnership with Swedish Health services for on-site care. We'll stop by this strikingly beautiful building, take a walk through the neighborhood, and conclude with a discussion of innovative approaches to permanent supportive housing at another of Plymouth's properties – Plymouth on First Hill.

Please note: we will walk to and from this off-site, which will involve approximately 1.5 miles of walking.
